A streetcar named Darby

History took to the streets Saturday in Darby, Colwyn and Yeadon Boroughs as a vintage 1947 PCC trolley car took guests on a ride along the oldest surviving trolley line. Fittingly, in the above scene, the trolley is passing the VFW Post in Darby Borough, the oldest VFW Post in Pennsylvania. The trolley rides were the main attraction of a trolley festival that took place along the trolley route. Sponsored by Sharon Bank and with the cooperation of Ed Springer of SEPTA, the historic trolley arrived to carry folks on a loop through Yeadon, Colwyn, Darby and Elmwood.
